Small Business Enterprise Centre and Community-Based Provider Locations

There are Small Business Enterprise Centres available around Ontario. These centres offer entrepreneurs the tools and resources to start and grow their businesses such as the following:

- Consultations provided by a business consultant, mentoring and networking opportunities

- Consultations through a lawyer or accountant referral service
- Up-to-date information for entrepreneurs
